

Biography

Nate Archibald is married to Mary Archibald. They have two children, Nate Jr. and Nicole.

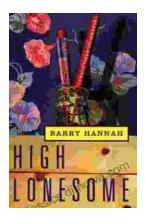
Archibald is a devout Christian. He is involved in several charitable organizations, including the Nate Archibald Foundation. The foundation provides financial assistance to underprivileged children.
